Entry fees:

Single Coop: \$3.00 per bird or \$2.50 per bird if entering ten or more birds.

Double Coop: \$5.00 per bird or \$4.00 per bird if entering ten or more birds.

Sales Coops: \$2.00 each (limit 4 birds per coop).

Outside sales permit \$10.00 (you supply the coops).

The 4-H club will be having a raffle at the show. Donations of items are always appreciated.

A food booth offering both breakfast and lunch will be provided by the 4-H club.

Show Rules

- All animals are entered and shown at the risk of the owner.
- Birds showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the show room at the discretion of the Show Officials and entry will be forfeited.
- All birds must be certified Pullorum Typhoid clean – including any birds for sale. A copy of the current certificate should accompany all entries. Waterfowl do not need to be Pullorum tested.
- Classes will be provided for Large Fowl, Bantams, Turkeys, Ducks, Geese and Guinea Fowl.
- This show will be judged by the American Poultry Assoc. (APA) Book of Standards and the American Bantam Assoc. (ABA) Book of Standards.
- The Judge's decisions will be final. In the event of any circumstances not covered by our rules, the show committee will make the final decision.
- Only judges, officials and owners will handle birds.
- "Youth" or "Junior" is an exhibitor 19 years of age and under
- Youth birds will be judged with the Open exhibitors.
- No day of show entries will be accepted.
- Be specific on your entries as to bearded, non-bearded, etc.
- All birds not marked as to large fowl or bantam will be considered large fowl.
- Poultry Show cages will be set up and assigned by the Show Secretary. birds cannot be moved without permission from the show secretary.
- Birds may be cooped in anytime after 7:30am. All birds must be cooped by 9:00am.
- Birds will be released after the awards presentation.
- All poultry awards will be given out after the completion of the show.
- GAPAA will not be responsible for any awards which are not sponsored by our association.

Youth Contests

Youth must sign in at the head table for contests

Judging

In this contest youth will be able to "be the Judge" and rank birds in order from 1st to 4th place based on how they conform to the APA and ABA book of standards.

There will be at least 4 classes of birds (consisting of 4 birds each) to be judged from the following classes: Bantams, Large Fowl, Bantam Ducks, Large Ducks, Geese, Turkeys, Guinea Fowl

Youth will not be allowed to handle the birds.

Age groups: 10 and under; 11 – 14; 15 – 19

GAPAA offers \$10 for Champion and \$5 for Reserve Champion in each age group.

Showmanship

Age Groups: 10 and under; 11 – 14; 15 – 19

GAPAA offers awards for Champion and Reserve Champion in each age group.

How To Fill Out the Entry Form

Breed: This is the breed as defined in the APA and ABA Standard.

Variety: This is usually the color. It may also include the comb type, and presence of beard.

Bearded / Non-Bearded: A cluster of feathers found on the upper throat of some breeds. This category of variety pertains mostly to the breeds of Polish and Silkies that have both bearded and non-bearded colors.

Cock: A male bird one year old or more.

Cockerel: A male bird less than one year old.

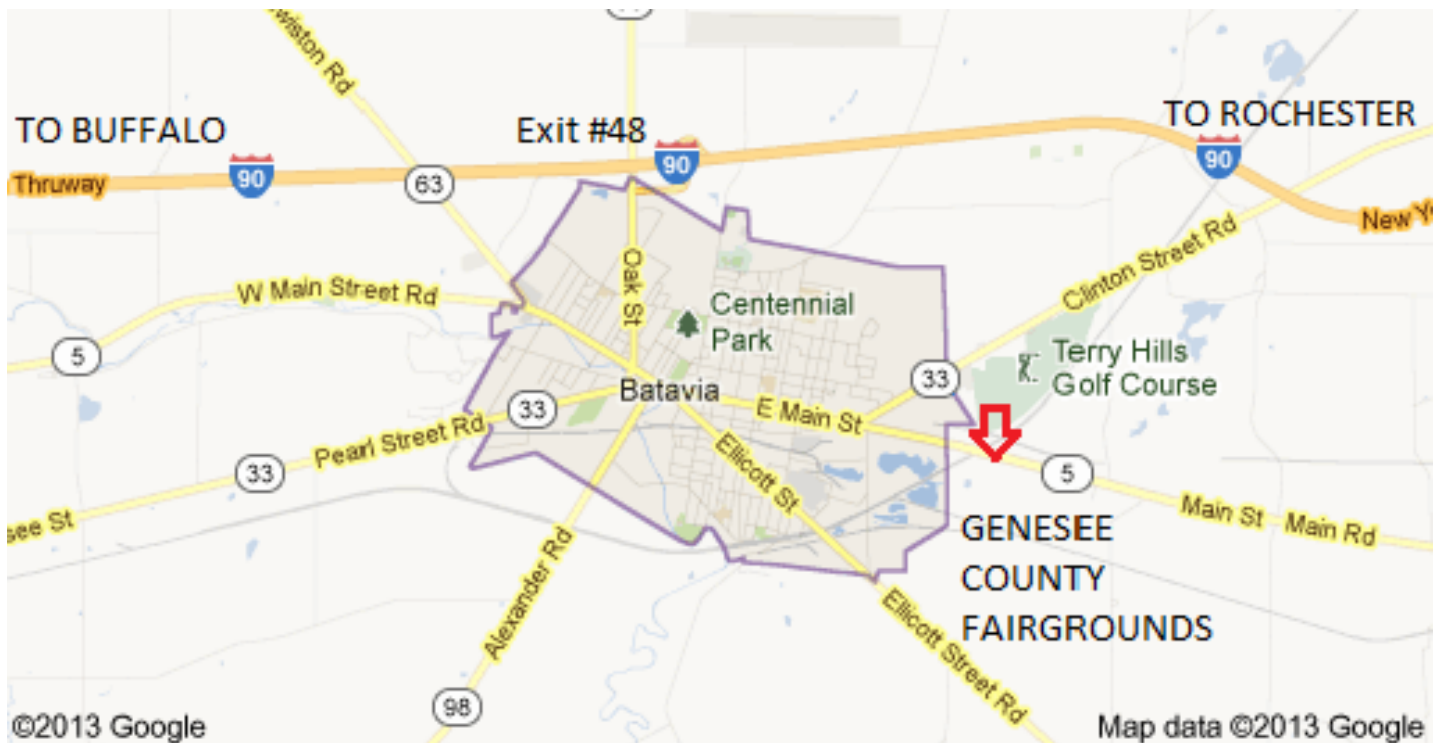
Hen: A female bird one year old or older.

Pullet: A female bird less than one year old.
